

New Combined Service Schedule for 2020

In November of 2019, the session approved the recommendations of a task group on the combined worship services, which consisted of an equal number of people from each Sunday service. Beginning in February, there will be a combined service on the third Sunday of each month at 10:00 AM, to further develop our unity in Christ as we worship together. This regular monthly pattern will be most helpful for people to remember. There will also be signage outside a full week in advance as reminders of the single 10:00 AM service that Sunday.

In the next few months staff members, committees and Session will be collaborating to create new opportunities for worship, discipleship, fellowship, and service and to address any impact to regularly scheduled events and programs. What Is Your Per Capita?

Per capita is the annual amount that Presbyterian churches pay for each member

to fund the ecclesiastical expenses of the Presbytery, the Synod, and the General Assembly. The 2020 per capita rate is \$34.79 per member, which comes to \$12,315.66. There is a 3% discount for paying quarterly.

If you receive numbered offering envelopes from us, there is a special blue envelope for the per capita contribution that provides the designation. If you have no blue envelope, you must designate your offering specifically for this purpose on the check or general offering envelope, or it can't be flagged for per capita.
